

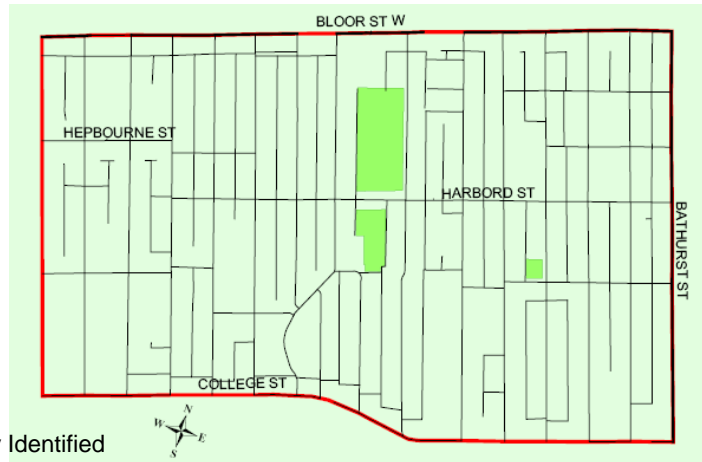
# Armour Heights
